These were large boats 80–90 feet in length with a beam of around 20 feet. Remaining stocks were sold cheaply to clear and many of these were converted to leisure yachts. A fishing trawler is a commercial fishing vessel designed to operate fishing trawls. Such a section was known as a made mast, as the two sections formed from Lancashire Nobby pieces of timber, which were known as pole masts.
